

Overview:

There are many myths around what Manufacturing is and we want you to explore them. A team of 3 students from years 7 to 12 are invited to connect with a manufacturing business in the GV. Students are to find out about the business, how many they employ, what does their business do and what job roles are offered in the business. From this information create a 2-3 minute video which must include a logo from the business, the Careers Day Out logo and their school logo. Make sure you get creative.

Only one entry from each school/alternative education provider will be accepted. The top entries will be invited to attend Careers Day Out Innovation and Activation Expo on Tuesday 30th April at the Multipurpose Pavilion Shepparton Showgrounds from 4.45pm. Presentations will be from 6.30pm.

Details for this challenge

Rules:

Students from Years 7 – 12 will represent the school/alternative education provider. Teams will consist of 3 students and a nominated team leader (Employee from the school). Teams do not

have to be from the same year level.

We encourage you to run a competition in your school and judge your top video to be sent through as only one team can be entered per school/alternative education provider.

Students and nominated team leader to arrange contact with the Manufacturing business. A list of businesses who will support this challenge will be supplied if you are unable to find one yourself.

Video:

Teams are encouraged to plan their videos and questions before attending the workplace to conduct the interview.

Video is to be no longer than 3 minutes of playing time but must be at least two minutes in length. To avoid issues with file sizes please upload your video to a YouTube account and email the link to hello@careersdayout.com.au

Attendance at the Event:

Students, the nominated leader and the business representative will need to be present on the night of the presentations.

If you are a finalist you will be invited to attend Careers Day Out Innovation and Activation Expo on Tuesday 30th April at the Multipurpose Pavilion Shepparton Showgrounds from 4.45pm.

You will be marked off and provided with a meal voucher each to purchase food from one of our food options on the night.

Teams will be provided details of where the presentation area will be. Presentations will be made at approx. 6.30pm.

The finalist videos will be played and then the winner announced.
